1 Enrollment

2 During the first twenty (20) days of school, students eighteen (18) years of age or older who have
3 been continuously enrolled in the District may register for classes through the standard
4 registration process. However, upon enrollment, such student must meet with the principal or
5 his/her designee to outline the school's academic and behavioral expectations of the student
6 during the school year.

7 A student eighteen (18) years of age or older who applies for admission must have the application
8 evaluated and approved by the principal when:

- 9 1. The applicant fails to enroll within twenty (20) calendar days after school officially
10 starts; or
11 2. The applicant has dropped out of school and wants to re-enter.

12 Exception shall be made if the student can show proof of satisfactory attendance in another school
13 system during the first twenty (20) day period, if a doctor's certificate states that illness has
14 prevented enrollment during the first twenty (20) day period, or if the district is required to permit
15 the student to enroll under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

16 Students not initially accepted for enrollment by the principal may contact the Department of
17 Student Services for possible enrollment.

18 Attendance

19 Any student having passed the compulsory attendance age may be dropped from the rolls after
20 three (3) consecutive unexcused absences or an aggregate of five (5) unexcused absences upon
21 approval of the Superintendent or his/her designee.
